Water Quality Programs, Progress, and Possibilities in Orange County

Please join us as Richard Boon and Amanda Carr present overviews of the County of Orange National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) and Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Programs, highlighting current and future program priorities, their implications for new development, and current progress measurements. These topics are especially important for environmental consultants to stay in touch with, as Orange County is moving ever closer to the implementation of more TMDLs and the next iteration of municipal NPDES stormwater permitting.

Richard Boon is a Supervising Environmental Specialist with the County of Orange with responsibility for administering the Orange County Stormwater Program. He has a BSc from the University of Leeds (UK) and post graduate diploma from Brunel University (UK). Prior to joining the County he has worked as an environmental policy advisor for the London Borough of Ealing, a field officer for the Environment Agency (UK), and as a geotechnical consultant for environmental and watershed management projects in the US and UK. He is currently chair of the California Stormwater Quality Association Policy and Permitting Sub-Committee and a member of the Chartered Institute of Water and Environmental Management.

Amanda Carr is the acting supervisor of the Water Quality Planning Unit, which manages the County of Orange Total Maximum Daily Load Programs. She has a Masters of Science in Environmental Science and a Masters of Public Affairs in Environmental Policy and Natural Resource Management from Indiana University's School of Public and Environmental Affairs. Prior to joining the County, she was a Superfund Project Manager at the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality.
