To show our support, we are pleased to offer one undergraduate and one graduate scholarship to students pursuing careers in the environmental field. Students currently attending universities in Orange County are encouraged to apply. Winners will be chosen based on their outstanding contributions in the fields of environmental science, policy, research, design, and/or other related disciplines.

Scholarship recipients will receive a monetary award of \$1,000 for the undergraduate student and \$2,000 for the graduate student. Complimentary one-year AEP student memberships will also be awarded, which include all the benefits of professional membership such as reduced rate Chapter luncheons and CEQA workshops, notification of networking events, subscription to the quarterly newsletter, and reduced rates for the Annual State Conference.

#### **Eligibility**

Applications will be accepted from continuing, full-time (12 units minimum) students attending 4-year colleges and universities in Orange County, who are pursuing careers that maintain an emphasis on environmental issues, challenges, or concerns. Minimum requirements include an official copy of current college transcript, a two-page essay (maximum length), two letters of recommendation, and a minimum 3.0 GPA.
